

## One-to-one Lessons (Private Classes)

### 2010 and 2011 - Prices per person in USD (US-Dollars)

**The price includes: course costs, accommodations (Hostal Las Mercedes), arrival transfer.**

Minimum duration: one week (five consecutive days/20 lessons) to begin on a Monday (first starting date in 2010: 11 January; first starting date in 2011: 10 January). However, under special circumstances, starting dates other than Monday and course durations of less than five consecutive days and/or 20 lessons per week may be considered.

The last course day in 2010 is 24 December. Officially, the EDEAQ is closed over Christmas/New Year. For students, who would like to extend their language course/stay beyond 24 December 2010 and into January 2011, individual arrangements, however, can be made.

The first day of the course will be used to identify and formulate, based on an assessment test and an oral interview, a personalised teaching programme, in view of specific goals to be elaborated by the student and his/her head teacher

For students who would like to prepare for the Diplomas de Español como Lengua Extranjera (DELE), the EDEAQ offers special courses of between 24 and 28 lessons per week.

#### The price includes

- **Arrival transfer** from Arequipa International Airport (AQP) or bus terminal(s) to the accommodations in Arequipa.
- **Course costs** (tuition fee), including didactic material (without dictionary). The length of a lesson is 55 minutes. – It goes without saying that you need to supply your own notebooks, pencils, etc.
- **Accommodations in the Hostal Las Mercedes**, including breakfast. – Room with private bathroom/shower-WC. – Internet access (desktop computer) in the lobby. – Walking distance to the school: approximately 10 minutes. – Length of stay in we one week = 6 overnights, two weeks = 13 overnights, three weeks = 20 overnights, etc. - Additional week = 7 overnights.
- **Support and advice** unrelated to the classroom as well as touristic information.
